- Commitment to continuous improvement in promoting diversity and inclusiveness in the workplace and the wider engineering profession.
- Positive impact as a result of diversity and inclusion strategies.

CRITERIA

- Entries are open to individuals, teams, firms or other groups
- Work substantially completed in New Zealand
- May include work by non-engineers
- Work substantially completed or initiative developed between November 2020 and November 2022
- Do not have to be Engineering New Zealand members
